The Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) has instituted various awards to be given on the Foundation Day every year. 6) Best Innovation Award (Principal/Director/Teacher):

(Total one Awards)

Gold Plated Medal, a Memento and a Certificate.

7) Felicitation of Principal/Director/Teacher – a Memento

Principal, Director, Teachers from College/ Institute/University Department /School / Centre, who has received prestigious academic Award from any institute of National/ International repute or from State/Central Government will be considered for felicitation.

• Eligibility Criterion:

1) Best College/Institute Award:

- a) College/Institute must be affiliated / recognized by the University.
- b) College/Institute must be functioning at least for 10 years.
- c) College/Institute should have been accredited/re-accredited by NAAC / NBA and such accreditation status should be valid on date of application.
- d) College/Institute must have an approved Principal / Director, appointed through proper channel.
- e) During the assessment year, no legal action in terms of fine or otherwise shall have been imposed on the concerned College/Institute as per Ordinance 179 (3) (a to q)

2) Best University Department/School/Centre Award:

- 1) The award will be given to University Teaching Department / School / Centre.
- 2) The University Teaching Department /School / Centre which has already received the award will be eligible to re-apply only after a period of 5 years.
- 3) The applicant Department /School / Centre should have submitted information required by IQAC, from time to time.

3) Best Principal/Director Award:

- a) Principal / Director should have been selected through proper channel and approved by the University.
- b) Principal / Director must have minimum 15 years experience as a teacher and 3 years experience as a Principal/Director in the College/ Institute affiliated to / recognized by the University.
- c) Three research publications in UGC approved / referred / peer reviewed National / International Journal during last 5 years.
- d) During the assessment year, no legal action in terms of fine or otherwise shall have been imposed on the concerned College/Institute as per Ordinance 179 (3) (a to q)
- e) No disciplinary action should have been taken or pending against the applicant.

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4) Best Teacher (other than Principal/Director) Award

- a) Teacher must be permanently approved.
- b) Teacher must have 10 years of total teaching experience after getting the approval.
- c) Ph.D. with at least five publications/research papers in referred/peer reviewed National/International Journals during last Seven years.
- d) Copies of self-appraisal report of last three years should be attached along with the application.
- e) No disciplinary action should have been taken or pending against the applicant.

5) Best Innovative Teaching Award (Principal /Director / Teacher):

- a) The teacher must have minimum 5 years of approved teaching experience.
 - 1) The Principal /Director /Teacher working in the College/Institute must have permanent approval. In case of Principal/Director approval for a term of 5 years.
 - 2) The teacher must have been appointed on a permanent basis in statutory Department of the University.
 - 3) The teacher must be a permanent employee of the University or have been appointed for at least 20 years.
- b) The teacher must have contributed to the development of innovative teaching method /skill, development, i.e., learning methods in a College/Institute University Department /School /Centre.
- c) No disciplinary action should have been taken or pending against the applicant.

6) Best Innovation Award (Principal /Director / Teacher):

- a) The teacher must have minimum 5 years of approved teaching experience.
 - 1) The Principal /Director / Teacher working in the College/Institute must have permanent approval. In case of Principal / Director approval for a term of 5 years
 - 2) The teacher must have been appointed on a permanent basis in statutory Department of the University.
 - 3) The teacher must be a permanent employee of the University or have been appointed for at least 20 years.
- b) The teacher must have developed an application having society output or granted patent in the last five years.
- c) No disciplinary action should have been taken or pending against the applicant.

7) Felicitation of Principal / Director/ Teacher:-

The University /College / Institute Teacher who is bestowed with an academic award during last year from any National / International reputed or from State / Central Government.

Note: It is not mandatory to felicitate teacher, if any teacher is not found suitable.

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8) General Conditions: (for all awards)

- a) The College/Institute which has already received an award will be eligible to re-apply only after a period of 10 Years.
- b) The University reserves a right to withhold some or all awards in case of unsuitability on any other ground.
- c) If the committee unanimously decides to consider any person, otherwise eligible for the award concerned, but he / she have not applied for the same, can consider his / her name for the award concerned.
- d) The Committee holds the right to nominate any College/Institute, Department for these awards.

These awards will be bestowed on the Foundation Day of the Savitribai Phule Pune University, every year i.e. 10thFebruary or on the date decided by the University.
