IRCC RESEARCH INTERNSHIP 2019-20

Indian Institute of Technology Bombay offers full time IRCC Research Internship to eligible bright students from academia for a period of six months starting from December to July every year. The interns are given an opportunity to work on challenging Research Projects as floated by IIT Bombay faculty. The interns are selected through written test / interviews for the chosen/applied projects. If selected, they are expected to work on the given project under the guidance of the Principle Investigator (PI). The research topics are available to prospecting candidates on the aforesaid website: "<https://drona.ircc.iitb.ac.in/ircc/NewFac/ResearchFellowshipProposalsReport.jsp>" The other relevant information is available on the IRCC website. Eligibility criteria and other conditions for the IRCC Research Internship 2019-20

- Applicant should be in the Second year of a Master's program, or third / fourth year of a Bachelor's program. Branch / discipline of study will be as per the project requirements specified by IIT Bombay Faculty (Internship Guide).
- Applicant should be among the top 10% or top 5 % (whichever is higher) in all the previous years in his/her discipline in the College / University / Institute. A certificate from the Principal (in the prescribed format) to this effect will have to be submitted at the time of submitting application.
- Intern should be able to work full-time for the Internship duration. Part-time internship is not allowed. A certificate from the Principal of the college to the effect that there are no course work requirements during the internship period has to be submitted at the time of submitting application.
- Applicant should be a full-time student while applying and till the completion of the Internship. Student may submit a partial project report before (e.g., in April) the completion of the Internship (e.g., in July) if the academic calendar of his/her College / Institute / University requires him/her to do so, with the prior consent of the Internship Guide of IIT Bombay.
