Online Entrance Examination (OEE) will be conducted for admission to MA (JMC) course (which is a four semester, credit point based full time Master's course revised as per NEP 2020)

Admissions to the course are granted strictly on the basis of merit in the **Online Entrance Examination** (OEE). Details of the OEE are available on

Eligibility: Any student with a bachelor's degree in any subject may apply for admission to the course. Those who are appearing for the final examination of a bachelor's course may also apply.

Course Syllabus: The course syllabus is available under 'Syllabus' on the department's webpage.

Pattern and syllabus of the OEE for MA (JMC) are as follows:

Total marks: 100 (Section A: **20** marks, Section B: **80** marks)

Time: Two hours

Section A: General Aptitude (20 multiple choice questions of one mark each)

Section B: Course-specific Questions

i) MCQs (**30** multiple choice questions of **two marks** each)

ii) Descriptive (**Four** questions of **five** marks each)

Section C: Interaction and Group Discussion about contemporary issues in hybrid mode (**25 Marks**) (Schedule and instructions will be separately mailed after OEE)
