Eligibility: Student with any undergraduate/ Bachelor's degree is eligible for this course

Total Credits for the Course: 40

Faculty: Science & Technology

Duration of the Course: The course will commence from September 2026 till July 2027 spreading for two semesters. Online sessions on Weekends viz. Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

Intake of the Course: The strength of class will be maximum 25 students including foreign nationals.

Medium of Instruction: English will be the medium of Instruction.
