Advertisement Three Years Integrated Course for Administrative Careers (ICAC) (2019-2022)

Administrative careers have started emerging as one of the most coveted career choice. Youth in Maharashtra have begun to see this as a challenging but secure, desirable and viable career option to professional courses like medical or engineering.

In view of the growing demand for competent coaching to aspirants for the UPSC Civil Services Examinations, the CEC has designed a three year "Integrated Course for Administrative Careers", focused on UPSC Civil Services preparation, students' capacity building through training in different skills with optimum use of university resource pool, available local talent and expertise as well as experts and academics available at the national level. Identification and optimization of use of quality textual material, digitization and modern E-learning resources will be the hallmark of the course. The course would nurture and serve the civil service aspirations of the youth and potential candidates without deviating them from their academic pursuit at the level of college, university or other institutes. The course combines an existing Part-time one-year post-graduate evening course of the CEC with a new two- years undergraduate course.

As a consequence of late career choice, the age gap between a student from Maharashtra and other leading centers (particularly in the north) is pronounced. By the time our students graduate and begin preparations for competitive examinations, they are in their mid-twenties which limits their future service career, besides facing the mounting pressure of employment/ job and career. (The average age at the entry-point is 25+). A close look at and analysis of the time taken by successful CEC students at the UPSC Civil Service examinations reveal that the average time taken is three- four years after joining the Centre for preparation. If these students' aspirations are nurtured soon after the 12th standard examination and guided properly, they would be ready as well as eligible for the competitive exam by the time they graduate.

Applications are invited for the admissions to Three Years Integrated Course for Administrative Careers (ICAC)

Duration of the Course: Three Years [Second Year + Third Year (Final Year) of the graduation + One year after Graduation

(Note: Classes will continue during the University vacation as well)

Entry Point: Second Year (SY) of graduation

Eligibility: Students who are in the Second Year (SY) of graduation under the SPPU and its affiliated colleges and institutions and on-campus departments: they will continue their normal academic careers.

Intake capacity: 40 (single batch)

Fee: Rs. 40, 000 (Forty Thousand Only) Per Year

(Note: Top Four candidates may be given 12.5 % fee concession/scholarship every year on the basis of the merit/overall performance during the year)

Reservation: As per the Govt. of Maharashtra and the SPPU rules for admission. There will be no fee exemption and concession on the basis of reservation.

Admission procedure: Admission for 2019-20 batch would be on the basis of marks obtained at the 12th Board examination.

Facilities: All facilities given to other students of the Center except hostel accommodation.





A close look at and analysis of the time taken by successful CEC students at the UPSC Civil Service examinations reveal that the average time taken is three- four years after joining the Centre for preparation. If these students' aspirations are nurtured soon after the 12th standard examination and guided properly, they would be ready as well as eligible for the competitive exam by the time they graduate. The focussed guidance from undergraduate stage will ensure that they are never under pressure as UPSC standards get covered in their curricula, they get exposed to recommended text books, reference material, develop ability of organizing thoughts and articulation through various skill-based activities and participation. The integrated course will prepare them for

civil services while keeping other career options open, without disturbing their core academic pursuits/ activities at their colleges and institutes. In fact, such additional exposure and preparation would strengthen their core academics in several ways.

A period of three years is necessary in order to prepare the aspirants at three different levels leading to holistic preparation, including development of personality and reasoning.

FOCUS OF THE COURSE _____

- a) Preparation for UPSC Civil Services Examinations at all the three levels (Preliminary, Mains examination and Interview)
- b) Capacity building: through writing practice / organization, personality development and articulative practices such as debate, group discussion, seminars, field visits, etc.

STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE _____

The three years course will consist of six internally divided course durations (of six month each), akin to semester system. The proposed course structure is as follows:

IST YEAR - BASIC

Part I (Semester I): NCERT Modules + CSAT+ Personality Development & English

Part II (Semester II): Optional Paper 1(concepts theories) as per UPSC Syllabus + Revision of NCERT/CSAT + Personality Development & English language

IIND YEAR -INTERMEDIATE

Part I (Semester III):

- a) Text Books Recommended for UPSC Preparation
- b) Optional Paper 2 (Application) as per USPC Syllabus
- c) English Language & Personality Development

Part II (Semester IV)

- a) Text Books Recommended for UPSC Preparation (cont.)
- b) Revision of Optional Paper 1& 2
- c) English Language & Personality Development
