The lecture will be delivered by Ven. Dhammadipa, a renowned Buddhist Scholar and meditation master.

About the speaker: Ven. Dhammadipa was born in Czechoslovakia, where he studied Chinese literature and philosophy. He later pursued his studies in Jerusalem, Berlin and Paris, before enrolling at the Nalanda University in India to study Sanskrit and Buddhist philosophy. He then lived in Japan, Sri Lanka and Burma, studying and practicing as a Buddhist monk under renowned contemporary masters of Buddhism. He has taught Buddhism extensively, in both theory and practice, and led students in meditation retreats in various countries.
