* Heidegger was averse to the use of terms like “culture” and “worldview” because of the misleading connotations they had accumulated with modernity and its technological culture. He sees the ideas of culture and worldview as born within the story of the conquest of the world as technologically representable picture. Despite Heidegger’s own reservations about the term “culture”, this paper argues that his hermeneutic phenomenology can provide adequate phenomenological ground for genuine and ontologically significant difference in our cultural experience of the world.
