Online Entrance Examination for Graduate & PG courses of SPPU

Pune -

In a major move to streamline admission and academic processes, Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) has decided to conduct Online Entrance Examination (OEE) for all post graduate and graduate level courses conducted on the University Campus from the academic year 2019-20. However, admission to all diploma and certificate courses will be given on the basis of the offline entrance examination conducted by the respective departments.

More than 80 post graduate and graduate level courses are conducted by various Departments and Centres on the SPPU campus. From the academic year 2019-20, admissions to all these courses will be given on the basis of merit in the entrance exam and almost all of them will follow the Online (OEE) pattern. Besides, more than 70 diploma and certificated courses are conducted by Departments and Centres on the campus. Admission to these diploma and certificate courses will be done on the basis of entrance examination conducted by the respective department. This year the Online Entrance Examination will be conducted sometime in the first or second week of June. Detailed schedule of the OEE and the online application process will be announced shortly, told Mr. Uttam Chavan, Deputy Registrar, P. G. Admissions.

The OEE will be conducted in several major cities in Maharashtra and metro cities across India. This will not only expand the reach of the admission process of the University but also help students to give the examination at a place more convenient to them. The OEE will streamline the entire process from the stage of application to admission to the course and hostel.

The OEE will be based on multiple choice questions and will consist of two sections. The first section of 20 marks will be based on logic, comprehension and general aptitude. The second section of 80 marks will be based on the subject specific knowledge required for the admission to the respective course.

Details on the online application form, eligibility criteria, admission process, syllabus for entrance examination etc will be announced shortly on the website of the University: www.unipune.ac.in

Similarly, the entrance examination for admission to Ph.D./ M.Phil. programme would also be conducted in June.
