Masters of Hindustani Classical Music

Concept Note

Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts presents "Masters of Hindustani Classical Music", a series of recordings reverberating the subcontinent's unbroken lineages in music. The repertoire of Hindustani Classical Music has been enriched by the contribution of various gharanas or schools of music for centuries. This ambitious project has been envisaged as a befitting tribute to the glorious masters of Hindustani classical music with a view to establishing periodicity, musical acumen and strengths of gharanas in an all-inclusive approach.

Pandit Shrikrishna Haldankar

The maestro has the distinction of being trained under renowned exponents of two gharanas — Jaipur-Atrauli gharana and Agra gharana. That experience of being groomed in two great musical traditions was like being in harmony with two as great tanpuras Babanrao later recalled in a book of critical essays aptly titled, Julupahanare don tambore (Two tanpuras trying to jive together).

Pandit Haldankar has made a unique contribution to Hindustani Classical Music. When he became director of Indian Music at the Goa Kala Academy in 1985, he initiated the ambitious project of standardisation of ragas on an All-India basis for which he invited noted artists of some well known gharanas as also musicologists. They helped to get 54 ragas standardised, which is considered to be a monumental achievement in the annals of modern Hindustani classical music.

Vidushi Dr. Suhasini Koratkar

A well-known exponent of Bhendibazaar gharana Vidusi Suhasini was born in the family of music lovers. Her father, Shri Ramrao Koratkar was an aircraft engineer while her mother, Smt. Sarla Tai had acquired some education in music. Due to her keen interest in music, her father supported and encouraged her to learn music from Pandit T. D. Janorikar.

Vidhushi Suhasini lent her voice to this beautiful genre of music and propagated this musical tradition through concerts and seminars. She has contributed several articles for popularizing Bhendibazaar *Gharana*. She earned her doctorate in 'Spiritual Importance of Indian Music'.


