5. Word limit: For each long-answer question maximum 500 words; for each short note maximum 200 words.
6. Question on Short Notes is NOT compulsory.
7. You can either type your answers in the space provided in the Moodle system OR upload a hand-written/ typed answer file (Microsoft Word/PDF/JPEG image)
8. In case of hand-written answer file, your images/ PDF must be clear.
9. In case of a hand-written answer file, you MUST write page number on each page.
10. Do not upload ALL your answers in the last 30 minutes of your examination time. It is advised that you upload each answer immediately after you write it.
11. This examination will be conducted in proctored mode. Before you start examination, you must give access of your device camera (mobile, laptop, etc.) to the browser.
12. If your device camera is turned off, the system will not allow you to take examination.
13. During the examination, make sure your devices (mobile, laptop etc.) are in good condition and have enough memory and battery backup.
