Instructions about (OEE) Online Entrance Examination of M.A (Education) 2024

Dear Sir / Madam,

This is hereby inform that, notification for the admission to all the PG courses conducted by departments on the campus for the year 2024-25 has been published on SPPU website on 20th April 2024. The Online Entrance Exam (OEE) will be conducted OEE for all the courses on campus which have degree/ degree plus (PG) as eligibility level will be conducted during 13 - 16 June, 2024. Please refer the notification for other details.

Department of Education & Extension is running M.A (Education) programme. Online Entrance Examination for the academic year 2024 - 2025 will be based only on MCQ type questions. The new Moodle like interface will be used for conducting online entrance exam. In this context OEE will be conducted as per the following guidelines:

The exam period would remain the same i.e. 2 hours and total marks would also remain the same i.e. 100 (Sec. A= 20 and Sec. B = 80) Questions for Sec A (general aptitude) is of 20 Questions for 1 Mark only.

In case more than one candidate securing equal marks in the entrance examination, marks in the Sec B (subject specific) will be superseding criteria. If the marks remain the same even at this level, then the marks in the qualifying examination will be considered for deciding the merit rank among them.
