The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) of India was established on 12th October, 1993. The statute under which it is established is the Protection of Human Rights Act (PHRA), 1993 as amended by the Protection of Human Rights (Amendment) Act, 2006. It is in conformity with the Paris Principles, adopted at the 1st international workshop on national institutions for the promotion and protection of human rights held in Paris in October 1991, and endorsed by the General Assembly of the United Nations by its Regulations 48/134 of 20th December, 1993. The NHRC is an embodiment of India's concern for the promotion and protection of human rights.

THEME OF THE TRAINING PROGRAMME

The principles of human rights education aim to promote dignity, tolerance and peace, by educating individuals and groups to respect, defend and advocate for their rights. Accordingly, it appealed to all countries to impart Human Rights Education starting from elementary level. Hence people living in the society have to discharge their duties with sincerity at all times without any deviation. Such practices will promote the freedom of all and could transform a society to achieve its objectives.
