
**Admission to MJMC\* Course July 2019**

Candidates selected for admission have to

- Fill the admission form online
- Report to the department on or before Saturday, July 27 between 11.30 am and 5.30 pm at Department of Communication and Journalism at Ranade Institute on Fergusson College Road, Pune 411004. (Please note that the department is NOT in the main university campus) with
  - Hard copy of filled admission form
  - ORIGINAL documents (certificates of basic educational qualifications, date of birth, certificate of domicile [or 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> mark lists] and caste/ caste verification/ income/ non-creamy layer/ physically handicapped/ sports-culture etc. as applicable) and one copy each of the documents for submission.
  - Eight I-card size coloured photographs.
  - Those selected under Sports/culture category should THEMSELVES get their documents verified by Director, Sports in the university and then submit the documents in the department.
- If all documents are in order admission payment link may be will be generated for the student. Students have to pay the admission fees on or before July 30, 2019.
- Those on waiting list will be notified after July 31, 2019.
- Classes will start from August 1, 2019 at 11 am. Regular attendance from first day is expected. Those who remain
