Admission to MA (JMC) Course (2021-22)

Online Entrance Examination will be conducted for admission to MA (JMC) course (which is a four semester, credit point based full time Master's course).

Anyone with a bachelor's degree in any subject may apply for admission to the course. Those who are appearing for the final examination of the bachelor's course may also apply.

The course syllabus is available under 'Syllabus' on the department's website.

Admissions to the course are granted strictly on the basis of merit in the Online Entrance Examination (OEE). Details of the OEE are available on www.unipune.ac.in under PG Admissions 21-22.
