Security deposit Rs. 1000 (will be refunded only if attendance of the student is above 75 % of the total classes conducted.)

3. One Passport Size Photograph

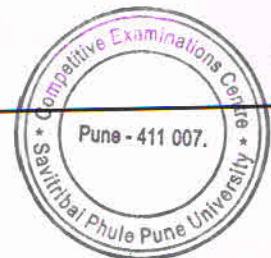
Objectives of the Crash Course

- Main objective of the Crash Course is to help students to get through the UPSC (Preliminary) Examination - 2020.
- Lectures will be primarily focused on UPSC Preliminary Exam Objective MCQ type question-answer discussion and conceptual clarity of the respective subject .
