- Professor Jagadish is a Distinguished Professor and Head of Semiconductor Optoelectronics, Nanotechnology Group in the Research School of Physics, Australian National University, Editor-in-Chief of Applied Physics Reviews & Editor of 3 book series. He has published more than 1000 research papers, holds 6 US patents, co-authored a book, co-edited 15 books & edited 12 conference proceedings.
- Professor Jagadish received many awards including IEEE Pioneer Award in Nanotechnology, IEEE Photonics Society Engineering Achievement Award, OSA Nick Holonyak Award, IUMRS Somiya Award, UNESCO medal for his contributions to the development of nanoscience and nanotechnologies, Lyle medal from Australian Academy of Science, Australia's highest civilian honor, AC, Companion of the Order of Australia, for his contributions to Physics in particular nanotechnology.
- He has been elected as President of the Australian Academy of Science and he is the first Australian of Indian heritage in this role.
